Purpose of Leadership Lodi

Since its beginning in 1990, Leadership Lodi has been designed to inspire and motivate Lodi area citizens to achieve higher levels of leadership responsibility. The ten-month program provides participants with the necessary information to understand the complexities of the Lodi community. In addition, the program will provide students with the opportunity to meet and exchange ideas with current community leaders. Participants will discuss, explore, and learn about topics such as leadership dynamics, government, education, law, agribusiness, economic development, health, and the arts.

Who Should Apply?

Leadership Lodi applicants should be seeking to enhance their leadership potential, increase their knowledge of the community, and be willing to commit their individual talents for future years for the betterment of the community of Lodi. Graduates of the program include individuals from a wide cross-section of the Lodi community, including representatives from both large and small businesses.

Commitment

Participants attend ten full-day class sessions held on the second Tuesday of each month. Additionally, class members must participate in the class project selected at a mandatory two-day retreat (March 17/18, 2018), and attend three community meetings. To graduate from the program, no more than two class days may be missed and “made up”. Partial day attendance, including late arrival, counts as an absence.

Tuition

Leadership Lodi is an educational program sponsored by the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce, a nonprofit organization. Tuition for Leadership Lodi is \$900 per student – a \$100 down-payment which must accompany the application, and \$800 which is due at the start of the first class in February. The tuition may be paid by the participant, by the employer, or through a sponsor. The Lodi Chamber of Commerce accepts payment via check, Visa, and MasterCard. Down-payments of individuals who are not selected will be fully refunded. Tuition is a tax-deductible education expense.

Selection of Participants

The Leadership Lodi Steering Committee is charged with selecting a diverse group for each yearly class.

Membership or past involvement with the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce does not ensure acceptance in the program, but applicants or their employers must be active members of the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce.

Application Deadline

The application deadline for enrollment is the last day of December. Appointments for personal interviews will be made throughout December and January.

To ensure your enrollment, please complete your application and submit it along with your down-payment as soon as possible. Only a limited number of participants, approximately 15, are accepted each year.

Commitment and Participation:

Graduation from this program requires the following participation and commitments. Please mark your initials on the spaces below indicating your understanding and agreement.

_____ Class sessions are scheduled from 7:45 am until 5:00 pm on the second Tuesday of each month from February through (and including) November. Participants may only miss a maximum of two full-day sessions. If any day (or part of a day) is missed, the participant must attend a community meeting (from a list of approved meetings) and submit a written review.

_____ In addition to any required make-up sessions, participants must attend three (3) community meetings or volunteer at six (6) opportunities. These can be done at any time during the year. A list of meetings will be provided to choose from.

_____ Time to return phone calls will *usually* be allotted during short breaks and lunch. Participants are not to use their mobile device during class, and may not leave the premises at any time, except for emergencies.

_____ Each participant must attend and contribute to the mandatory retreat in March. This event, on March 17 and 18 (Saturday at 8am through Sunday at 4pm, including drive time), will be spent planning your class project. This retreat is only for participants (no spouses, children, etc).

_____ Volunteer time is required to plan for – and complete – the selected class project, often in evenings and weekends. Participants can expect to spend 10-30 hours on the project between April and October.

_____ Applicants, or their employers, must be an active member of the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce.

_____ Participants must have their employers' approval to join Leadership Lodi, including the commitment and participation it requires which often conflicts with work schedules. This includes class sessions, the retreat, volunteering towards the class project, and any other meetings and commitments that may arise.

_____ While attending sessions and working on the class project, participants are expected to represent the Leadership Lodi program with the utmost of professionalism and respect toward others.

_____ Prior to a successful graduation from the program, participants shall have identified an area of volunteer community service, and shall have offered their ongoing commitment to that organization.
